CAREER OPTIONS

A SAC-IT certification in Wisconsin enables you to work in entry-level addiction treatment roles, such as a Substance Abuse Counselor, AODA Counselor, Intake Specialist, or Behavioral Health Technician.

These positions are available in city jobs, rehabilitation facilities, outpatient clinics, DOC facilities and community health agencies, with common pay ranging from \$19-\$27+/hr.

We accept private pay for all services. Individuals may be eligible for financial assistance through public workforce and support programs. Qualified applicants are encouraged to contact their local W-2, FSET or DVR program offices to determine eligibility for voucher-based funding.

Our program is also listed on the Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development's Eligible Training Provider List (DWD-ETPL), which may provide additional funding opportunities for individuals who meet program requirements.
